- 1 Commit to making attendance a priority (if student needs to miss a session they will let the leaders know ASAP). If they have to miss a session they are required to give a valid reason.
- 2 Commit to serving at Creekside in some capacity (children's ministry, parking lot, tech and worship ministry, TNT leader, etc.)
- 3 Commit to sitting with the Student Leaders group every other Sunday during the 9:45 service (the service right before our sessions) and modelling engagement in the worship service for the rest of the Creekside community.
- 4 Commit to being at REVOLUTION on Wednesday nights and helping with assigned tasks and responsibilities there.
