How To Grow a Healthy Heart

Psalm 139:23-24

Above all else, guard your heart, for everything you do flows from it.

Proverbs 4:23 NIV

God speaking through the prophet Samuel to King Saul said,

"But now your kingdom will not endure; the LORD has sought out a man after his own heart and appointed him ruler of his people, because you have not kept the LORD's command."

1 Samuel 13:14

And the one of whom he spoke of, as being a man after his (God's) own heart, was David.

What does it mean to be a person after God's own heart?

Psalm 139:23a

David asks God to

- know my heart,
- · know my anxious thoughts,
- and to see if there is any offensive way in me.
