1 Samuel 18:1-4: 19:1-20:42

1. CONNECT THROUGH SHARED VALUES:

The soul of Jonathan was knit with the soul of David, and Jonathan loved him as himself.

1 Samuel 18:1

The more vital the value the more intimate the friendship.

2. HONOUR THAT PERSON ABOVE YOURSELF:

Jonathan took off the robe he was wearing and gave it to David, along with his tunic, and even his sword, his bow and his belt.
