GOD QUESTIONS

How Can God Allow all this Evil and Suffering?

The Challenge Is Posed Like This:

- 1. A good God would destroy evil.
- 2. An all-powerful God could destroy evil.
- 3. Evil is not destroyed.
- Therefore, there cannot possibly be such a good and powerful God.

HOW ARE WE TO UNDERSTAND THE PRESENCE OF SUFFERING AND EVIL?

1. MANY ACCEPT THE EXISTENCE OF EVIL AND GOD

Does the presence of suffering automatically mean the absence of God? To believe wholeheartedly in a loving and omnipotent Father, do I have to paper over the reality of evil and pain around me?
