

HOW TO START A REVOLUTION The Way The Spirit Moves




God the Father . . . Abba God the Son . . . Jesus God the Holy Spirit . . . Pneuma, Ruach

THE ACTS OF THE APOSTLES HOLY SPIRIT

1. HE IS THE PROMISED GIFT:

Now he is exalted to the place of highest honor in heaven, at God's right hand. And the Father, as he had promised, gave him the Holy Spirit to pour out upon us, just as you see and hear today.

Acts 2:33



2. HE IS THE POWERFUL GIFT

"Do not leave Jerusalem, but wait for the gift my Father promised, which you have heard me speak about. For John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit."

... But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

We do not realize how powerful the darkness is and how much the Holy Spirit does to keep it at bay.

Notice that we are not given power to witness we are given power to be witnesses.

But Stephen, full of the Holy Spirit, looked up to heaven and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing at the right hand of God.

2. HE IS THE PERSONAL GIFT:
